Fausty. Receive call ... hello.

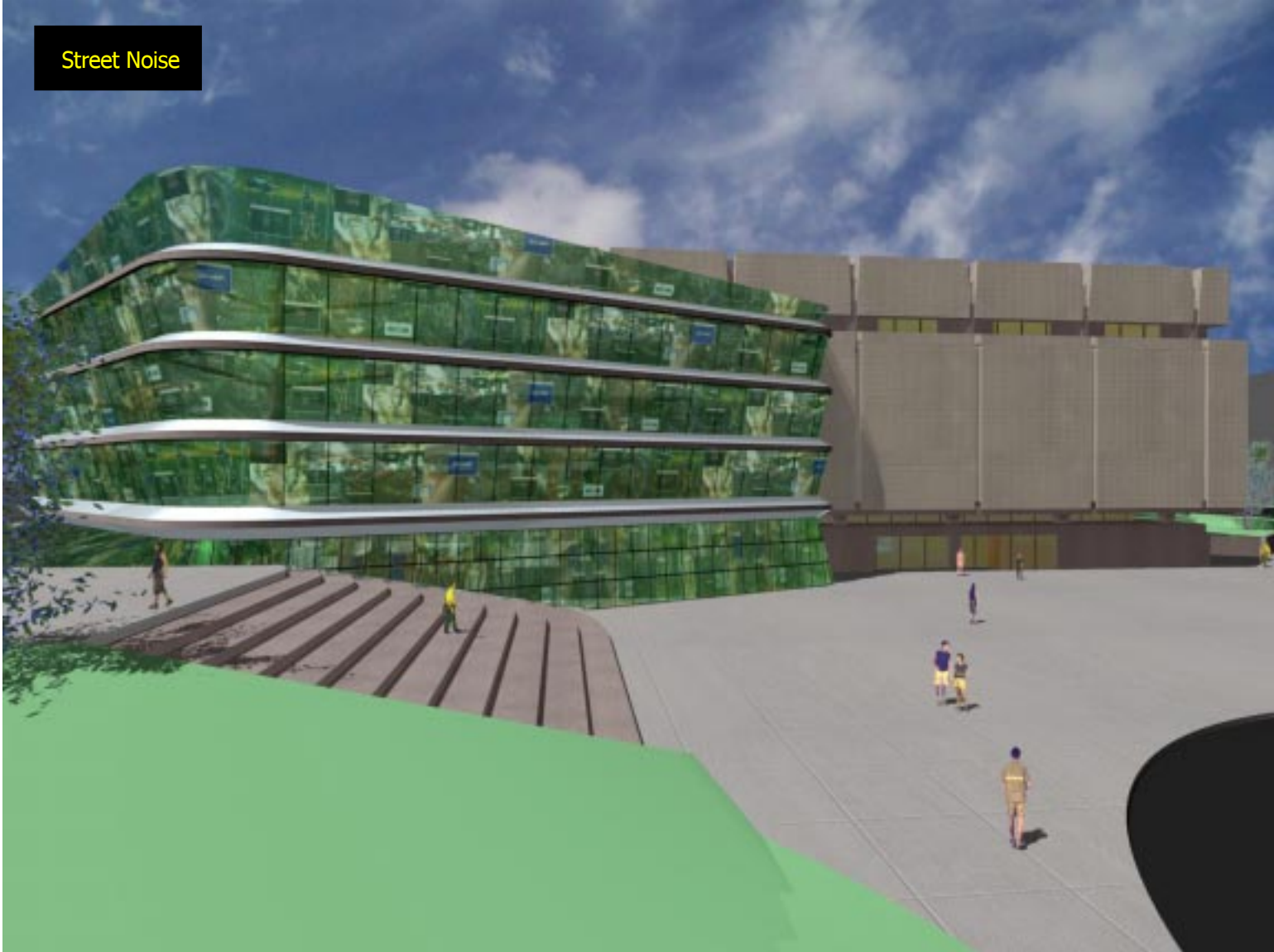

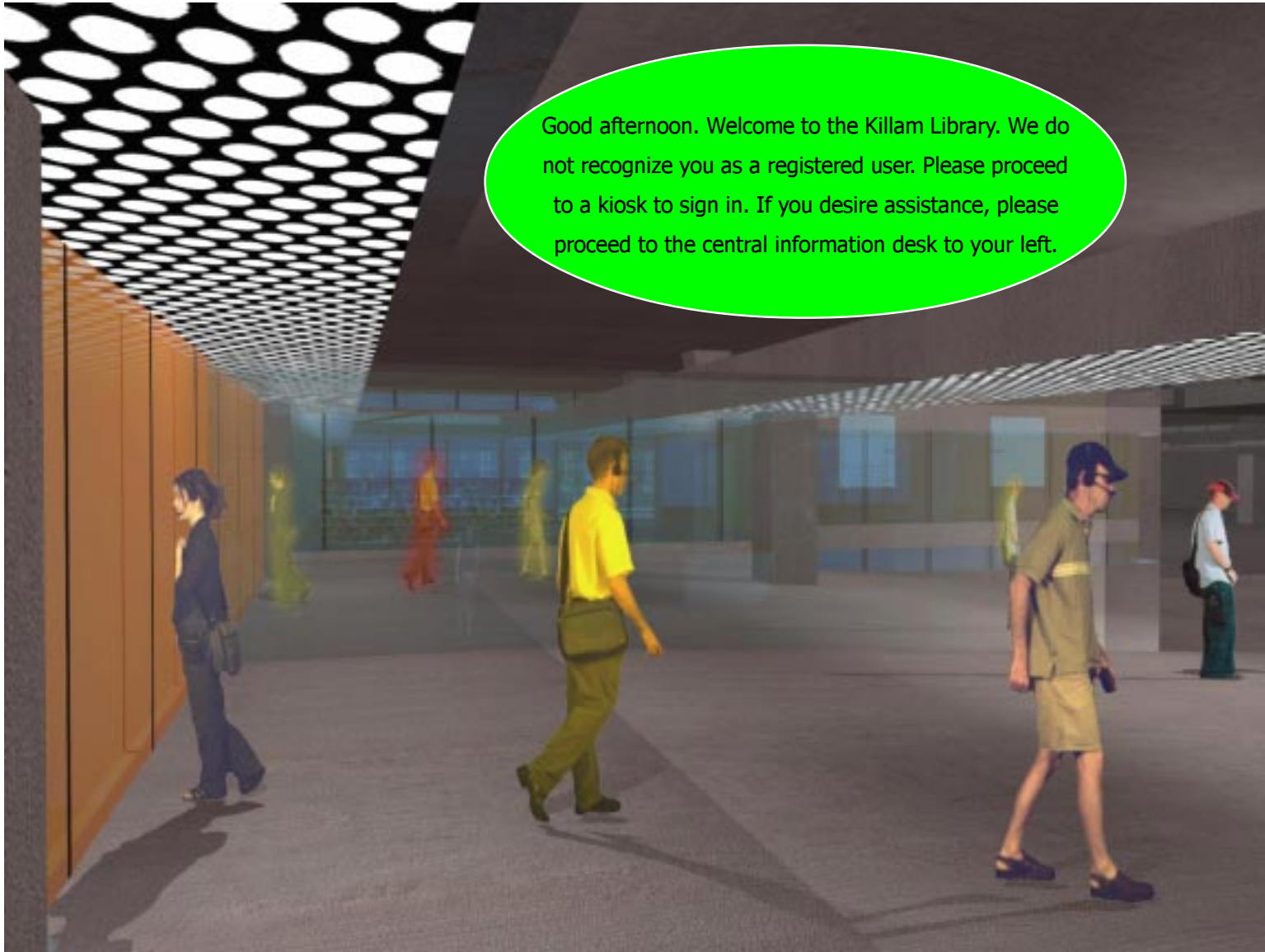

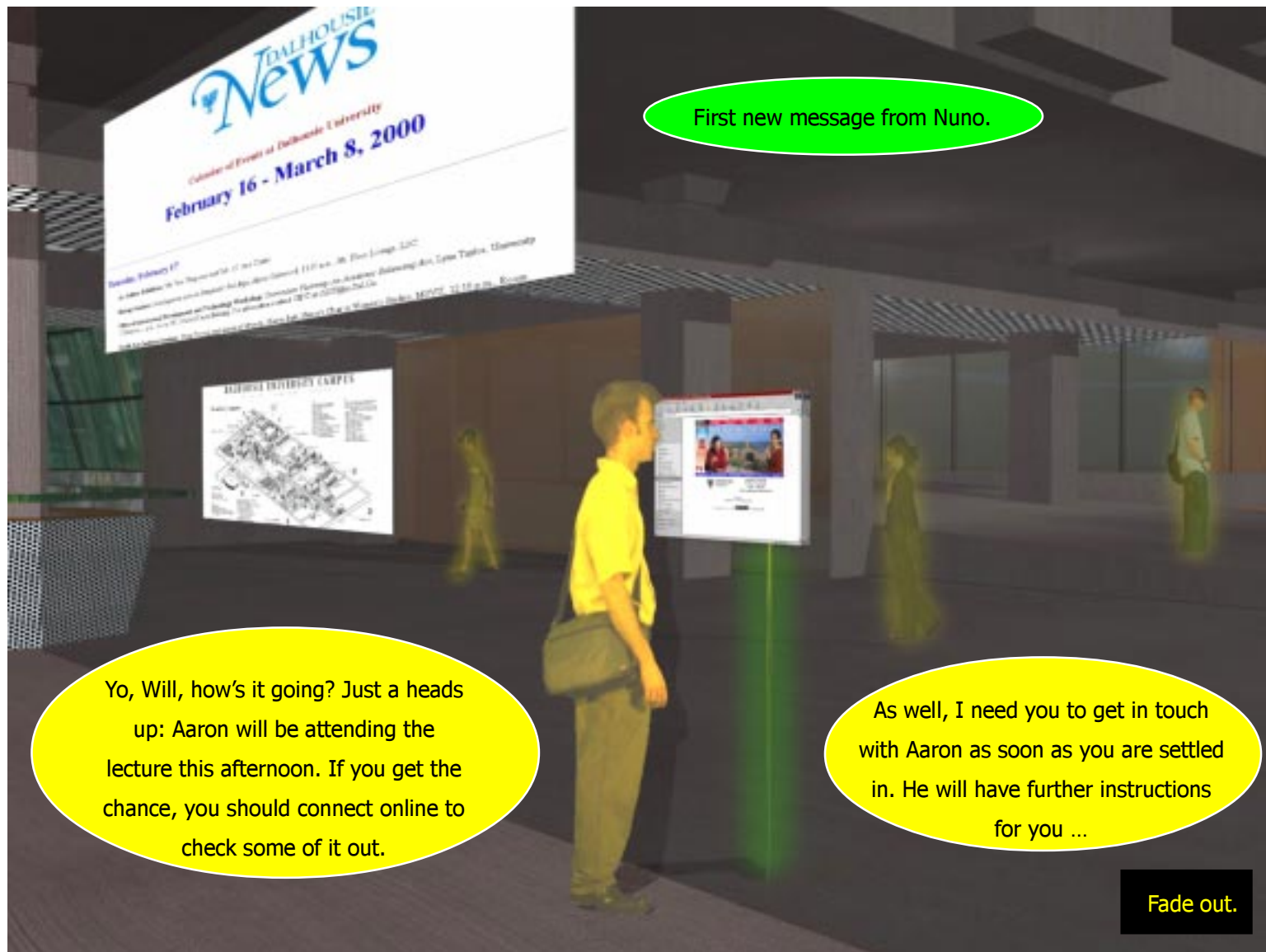


Street Noise

All right, cool. So can I sign out an in-house unit for the day?











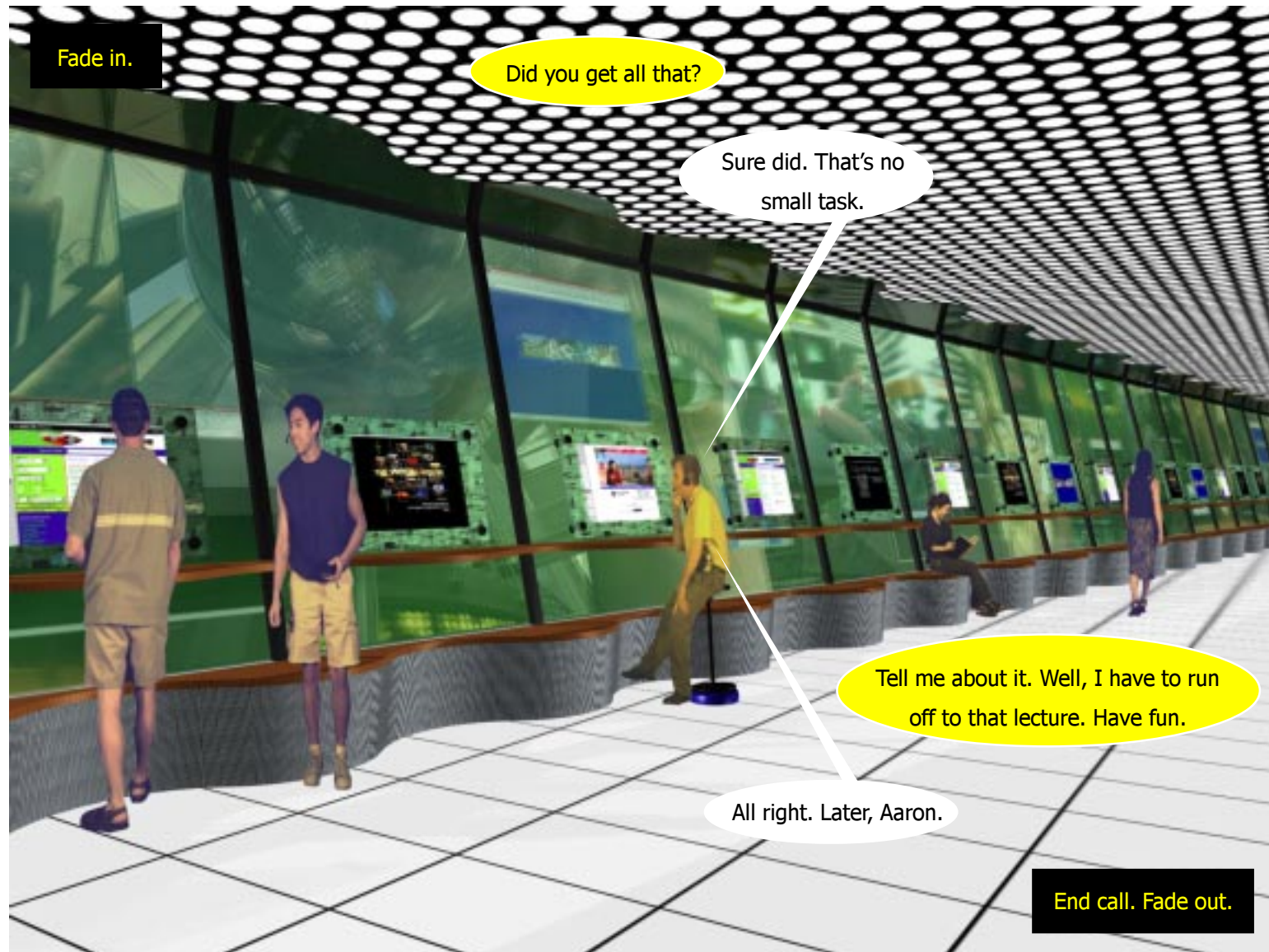
Fade in 5 minutes later.

Yeah, count on it.

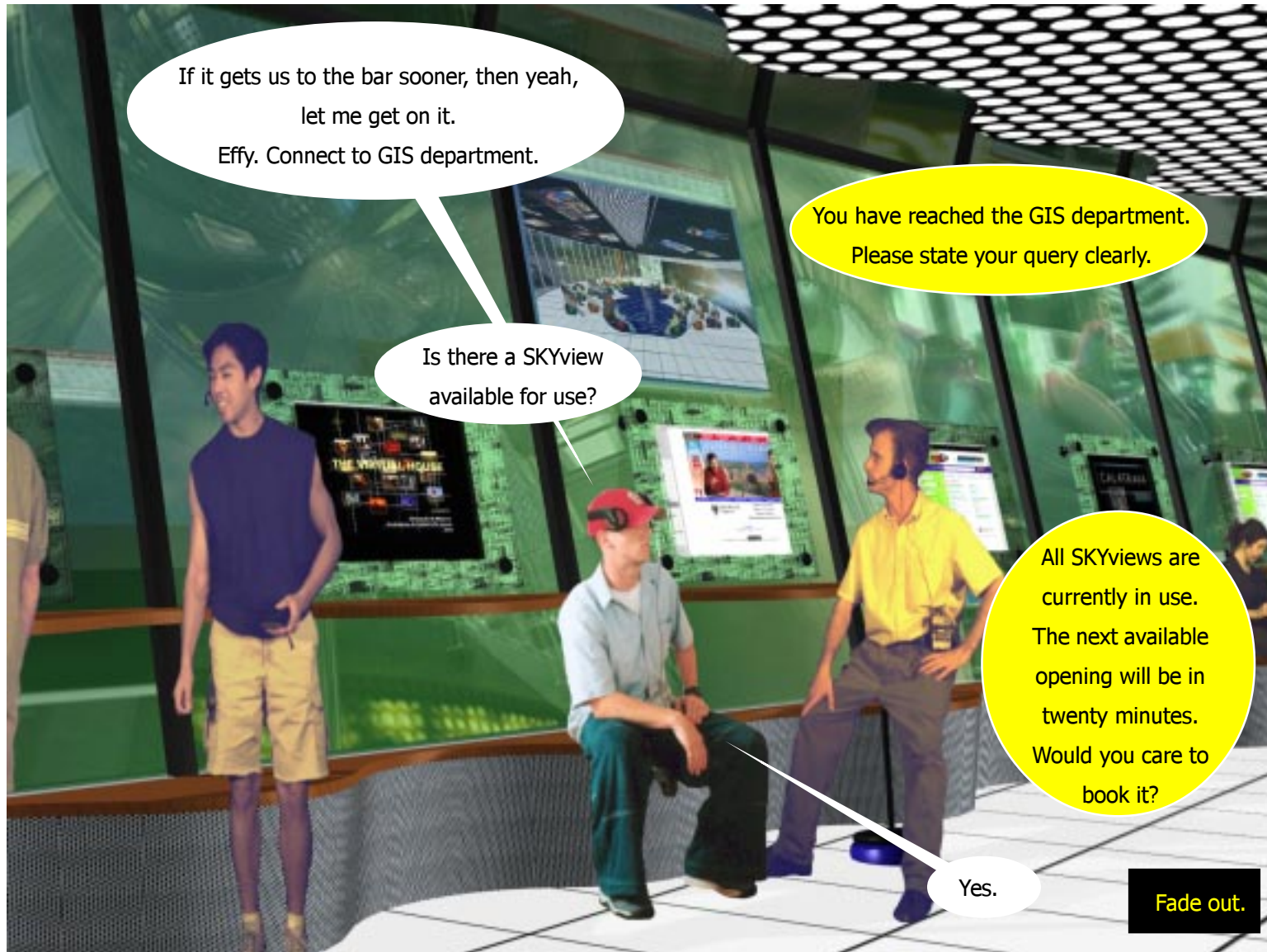

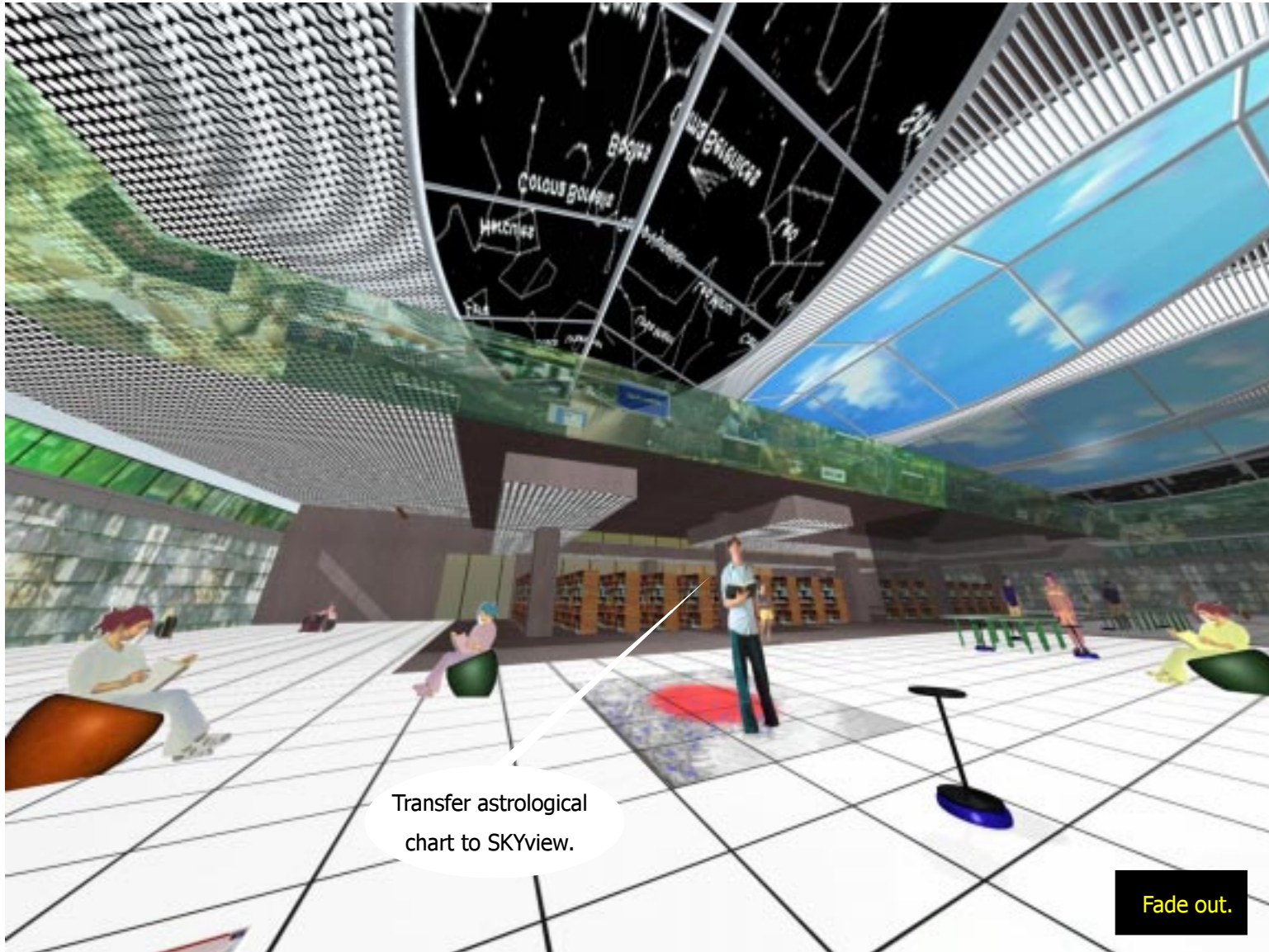












Fade in.

Anyhow, we were lucky enough to have a copy sitting in the archives. I just dropped it off at the Electronic Text Centre. They should be sending you something within the hour.

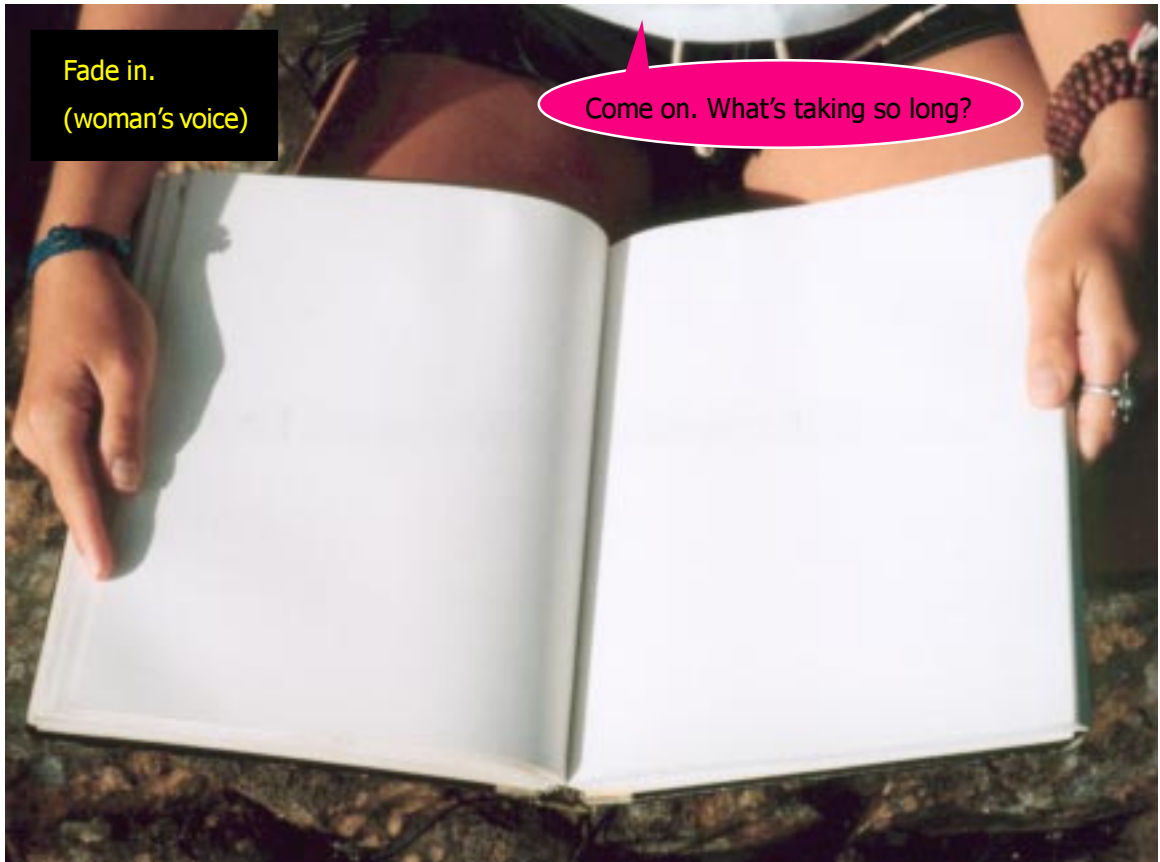
Good work guys. Have one on me tonight.

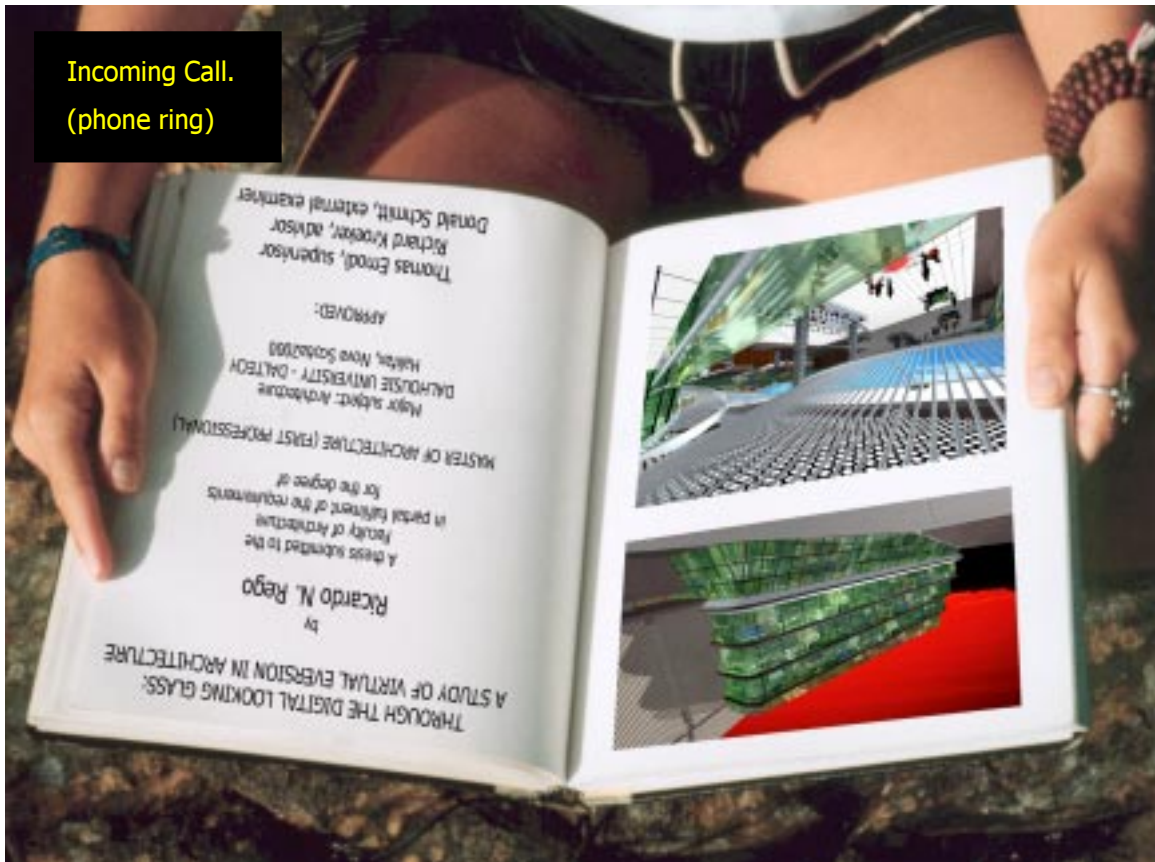
